EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Club policies/rules:

- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by dogs and handlers at all times.
- All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in NADAC agility trials. Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge not to be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health, and welfare of the dog.
- If you are sending entries by express carriers you **MUST** waive the signature requirement for receipt (make sure the carrier allows this), otherwise entries may not be received in time and will have to be rejected. **All entries must be delivered to the mailing address listed on the entry form in order to be accepted.** An entry must include the entry form, agreement and signature in their entirety. A separate entry is to be submitted for each dog.
- **Move ups between days will be accepted.** Move-up forms must be filled out and given to the Show Secretary by the end of the last class of the day on the first day of the trial.
- The Organizing Committee may refuse any entry on basis expressly provided by NADAC rules and regulations or guidelines established by NADAC Board of Directors. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.
- All entries will be confirmed via email only and where a valid address is supplied. Please ensure that the email address you provide is legible and valid.
- A few pieces of equipment will be provided for warm-up purposes. No other practise equipment is permitted at the trial site. In accordance with NADAC rules, the warm up equipment is never to be used by dogs not entered in this competition.
- After the closing date, refunds will be considered on a case-by-case basis and will be solely at the discretion of the Club. Exhibitors may be required to submit a veterinarian's certificate. No entry will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the club. All refunds will be processed after completion of the trial. Refunds made will be less any NADAC or other administrative fees owing on the entry.
- Tendering a NSF cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry. There will be a \$25.00 CDN charge on all returned cheques whether or not the dog and handler compete in the event.
- Entry fees are payable in Canadian or US funds. **Post-dated cheques do not constitute a valid entry.** Overpayments of \$10.00 (either currency) or less will not be refunded.
- Please be aware that crating space may be tight. Stack crates whenever possible. Use of x-pens is discouraged, but will be allowed for exhibitors with multiple dogs.
- Bring your own chair. Since space may be tight exhibitors are encouraged to make use of the upper level viewing area instead of setting up their own chairs
- This is a horse facility, please keep dogs away from any horses.
- **All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring or in the warm up area.**
- **Overnight kennelling is NOT permitted at the trial site.**
- We will accommodate handlers running more than one dog to the extent possible. Running order will be determined at the clubs discretion.
- NADAC rules regarding leads, collars, food, toys, balls, clickers or other aids/devised are in effect for this trial including the use of such items within ten (10) feet of the ring entrance/exit.
- **Food/toys in pocket:** NADAC policy now allows that food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a ziplock bag or small container such as a pill bottle. The container cannot be visible in the ring nor within ten (10) feet of the ring. You cannot indicate to your dog that you have this item on you – ie: patting your pocket. You are not allowed to remove the container until you are at least ten (10) feet outside the ring.
- Changes to entries (only for purposes of advancing entry to a higher class level) will be accepted via phone (204) 661-2234, or e-mail to ddenbow@mymts.net until 6:00 p.m. CDT, February 27, 2012 for those dogs that finished titles at shows held after the closing date. Changes will be accepted only for entries received by the published closing date of February 17, 2012.
- It is expressly understood that competitors ALONE are responsible for the behaviour of their dogs and/or children. Any competitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial grounds and NO refunds of fees paid will be made.
- **ABUSE, IN ANY FORM, OF TRIAL WORKERS, COMPETITORS OR THE JUDGE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. ANYONE DISRUPTING THE TRIAL DUE TO ANY SUCH BEHAVIOUR WILL BE DISMISSED FROM THE TRIAL WITH NO REFUND OF ANY FEES PAID.**

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM NADAC

IMPORTANT. Please check to be sure your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any discrepancies to the Club's trial secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at the higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

CHECK-IN AND MEASURING

- Check-in/measuring will be announced in your trial confirmation.
- You only need to check in once.
- To facilitate check-in and measuring **please include a photocopy of your dog's registration/permanent height card with your entry.** NOTE: Only dogs jumping 16" or less in the Standard division or 12" or less in the Veteran or Junior Handlers division require measuring and can obtain a height card. If included, please attach to the general agreement using a paperclip. If you have previously submitted a copy of your dog's registration and/or height card, there is no need to submit again. Dog's entered in the "Skilled Division" do not require a height measurement.
- Briefings and start of first class to immediately follow check-in each day.
- Tentative running order will be Elite, Open, Novice.
- Jump height order will be ascending on Saturday, descending on Sunday.

NON-JUMPING CLASSES – VETERAN OR DISABLED HANDLER

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1. As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
2. As used here Hi-Flyers means Hi-Flyers Agility Training, its members, officers, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
3. Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
4. Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the State/Province in which the dog resides.
5. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
6. Exhibitor/owner release NADAC, HI-FLYERS and WW Stables (Including NADAC, HI-FLYERS and WW Stables officers, employees and members), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
7. The personal information collected herein is for the purpose of enabling you to participate in our trial as a competitor. The personal information you have provided will be used by HI-FLYERS to administer this event in accordance with the NADAC rules governing the hosting of an agility trial. The personal information will be disclosed, in accordance with the NADAC rulebook for any trial reporting obligations. In addition it may be used to contact you about future HI-FLYERS events.
